



Shiraz-Cabernet

South Eastern Australia

Ripe, rounded Blackcurrant and blackberry fruit and a lick of peppery spice, make this so approachable and enjoyable. Soft, supple tannins add to the flavour, with becoming overpowering.....lovely

Short Mile Bay Merlot 2014

South Eastern Australia

The perfect choice if you're at all unsure which red to choose, this Merlot is soft, rounded, with fresh plum fruit, soft tannins and is medium-bodied.

Paso Malbec 2013

Mendoza Valle de Uco Argentina

Malbec is possibly the red grape of the moment – not too full and heavy, but with a bit of black pepper, blueberry fruit and a touch of soft plum.

Fruity, dry and made without the use of oak, this Chablis is classic Burgundian Chardonnay which lets the lovely gentle fruit show through.

Soellner Fumburg

Gruner Veltliner Wagram

From completely biodynamic and organic vineyards, this Gruner Veltliner is produced from old vines, treated with the utmost respect. The result is a rich, full and complex wine, aged in oak and on its lees for 8 months, but perfectly balanced so as not to overpower the lovely fruit character.

Waipara Hills Sauvignon Blanc Marlborough New Zealand

The epitome of great Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc is aromatic gooseberry and passionfruit and this wine has those in spades. Bags of flavour, but with a crisp, linear edge and great balance throughout. Gold medal winner in the Sommelier Wine Awards in 2015.



Rich, deep, complex and spicy, this is a brilliant traditional style of Rioja, but with a modern, fruit-led twist. Aged for up to a year in oak, to give extra depth and richness to the blackberry, damson and dark cherry fruit.

Chateaufeuf Du Pape

Les Cornalines

£29.95

Dominated by Grenache and Syrah, this Chateaufeuf du Pape is full-bodied without being overly tannic or aggressive, with rounded fruit and great balancing freshness and a long finish. I would recommend giving this a little time to air before drinking, just 10 minutes in the glass prior to enjoying will help.

Soft, fresh, clean and very easy-drinking, this South African red is easy to drink on its own. A touch of spice compliments the plum fruit throughout
